ON BASELINE EDUCATION CENSUS, UGANDA AQUACULTURE CENSUS AND LABOUR MARKET SURVEY

The Uganda Bureau of Statistics (UBOS) in collaboration with the Ministry of Education and Sports, Ministry of Agriculture, Animal Industry and Fisheries and Ministry of Gender, Labour and Social Development is conducting Baseline Education Census, Uganda Aquaculture Census and Labour Market Survey. UBOS would like to assure all stakeholders that data collected will be treated with utmost confidentiality.

BASELINE EDUCATION CENSUS 2025

The Baseline Education Census 2025 will cover all learning institutions in the Country for both Government and Private establishments namely, Pre-Primary, Primary, Secondary, Vocational and higher institutions of learning.

The exercise will collect information on Learners, Teachers and Institution's infrastructure to facilitate planning and policy decisions in the Education Sector. The exercise will be taken from 7th April to 30th June 2025 starting with Greater Kampala Metropolitan Area.

The Census will cover the following areas;

- (i) Information on learners – Bio-data
- (ii) Institution and ownership
- (iii) Teaching and Non-teaching staff,
- (iv) Learning materials,
- (v) Institution's infrastructure

UBOS calls upon all Heads of Education Institutions and parents of the Learners to support the exercise by availing Learners with their correct date of birth, National Identification Number (NIN) and Learners Identification Number (LIN).

AQUACULTURE CENSUS 2025

Aquaculture Census 2025 will be conducted starting May 2025. The exercise will provide the primary source of structural data on Aquaculture, providing benchmark information on the number, size and distribution of Aquaculture holdings, characteristics of the Aquaculture households, land use and other inputs.

The exercise will collect comprehensive and accurate data on the Aquaculture sector in Uganda.

The Census will generate information on;

- (i) The number of Aquaculture farms.
- (ii) Production levels, technologies and types of aquaculture systems in use.
- (iii) Socio-economic data on aquaculture operators and their households.
- (iv) Environmental impact of aquaculture activities.

All Aquaculture farms by type will be visited both in the household and non-household sectors.

LABOUR MARKET SURVEY

The Labour Market Survey is on-going. Enumerators are collecting data in households, formal and informal sectors across the country. This survey will provide statistical data and information on Labour market dynamics to inform effective planning.

The Labour Market Survey will particularly focus on the following;

- (i) Monitoring Labour Market Trends
- (ii) Assessing Labour Demand
- (iii) Assessing Labour Market Efficiency

UBOS APPEAL

The Uganda Bureau of Statistics appeals to all Local Government Authorities, key stakeholders and the general public to support these activities by providing accurate data to the Enumerators.
